REGULAR SESSION

The Regular Session of the Idaho State Board of Accountancy was called to order at 9:06 AM with Chair Lela D. "Kitty" Pumphrey, CPA presiding. The Board adjourned to Executive Session at 9:08 AM. The Executive Session concluded at 10:45 AM. A break was taken until 10:53 AM. The Regular Session reconvened immediately thereafter. The Regular Session recessed for a break at 12:10 PM and reconvened with a working lunch at 12:20 PM. At 1:00 PM a hearing for failure to renew was called to order. The Board adjourned to Executive Session at 1:40 PM and returned to Regular Session at 1:53 PM; adjourned to Executive Session at 2:00 PM; returned to Regular Session at 2:15 pm; again adjourned to Executive Session at 2:40 PM and returned to Regular Session at 3:20 PM. The Regular Session adjourned at 4:06 PM.

ROLL CALL: The following members of the Board were present:

ISCPA President Lavern Gentry, CPA, ISCPA Executive Director Melissa Nelson, and ISCPA Peer Review Coordinator Tracy K. Poe along with Linda Trent, CPA, representing the Idaho Association of Public Accountants, joined the meeting after the Executive Session for Regular Session sections.

1. CONVENE REGULAR SESSION

(A) Approve Minutes: Mr. Rasmussen moved to accept the minutes of the June 18, 2002 Regular Session as written with the recommendation of using "moved" in place of "motioned" in future minutes. Mr. Etter seconded. Motion carried.

2. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Ms. Pumphrey, Chair, citing *Idaho Code* Section 67-2345 (1)(b)(d) & (f), called for a vote to adjourn to Executive Session for discussion of personnel issues, complaints, disciplinary proceedings and applicant special considerations. All members of the Board present voted as follows: Jim Pilcher, CPA, yes; Larry Bird, CPA, yes; Tom Jones, CPA, yes; Don Etter, yes; Craig Rasmussen, CPA, yes; Kitty Pumphrey, CPA, yes. When the Regular Session resumed, the Board addressed the items from the October 2, 2002 Executive Session.

(A) Review Minutes: Mr. Rasmussen moved to approve the June 18, 2002 Executive Session minutes as amended. Mr. Etter seconded. Motion carried.

- (B) Advice from Legal Counsel: In response to a Board member inquiry during the June 18, 2002 Board Meeting, Mr. Hunter informed the Board that Executive Session minutes are required by law. However, they are exempt under the Public Records act when dealing with disciplinary or personnel matters.
- (C) Status Reports Review of Complaints and Cease & Desist Activity
- 1. Update on Open Dockets: Mr. Hunter updated the Board on Docket 2002-12.
- 2. Cease & Desist: Ms. Porter and Ms. Lenon reported the status of C&D files.
- (D) Special Consideration: Examination Applications for AP-001635, AP-001595, AP-0021628, AP-001631, AP-001570 and AP-001452 were brought to the Board's attention in Executive Session for special consideration. Action was taken in Regular Session Item 6.C. Licensure An application for special consideration was brought to the Board's attention in Executive Session for special consideration. Action was taken in Regular Session Item 7.A. Mr. Rasmussen moved to expunge the records of disciplinary file Docket 1999-06 as stipulated in the final order. Mr. Etter seconded. Motion carried. (E) Personnel Matters: Board members discussed the issue brought to the Board's attention by Mr. Paul Moore. No action taken.

3. FIRM REGISTRATION AND PEER REVIEW PROGRAM

- (A) Review/Approve Administering Organizations: Mr. Jones moved to accept the list of Administering Organizations as recommended by the Peer Review Oversight Committee for 2002/2003. Mr. Etter seconded. Motion carried.
- (B) Federal Privacy Act: Mr. Jones recused himself from Board discussion of Mr. Arnold's letters to the Board regarding Peer Review and the Federal Privacy Act. Mr. Hunter discussed the issue and advised the Board on future correspondence and action. Mr. Hunter stated that Board members can perform Peer Reviews as part of their private practice. However if a conflict arose, the Board members would recuse themselves from issues dealing with licensees for whom Board members had done Peer Reviews. Mr. Rasmussen moved to direct the Staff and Board Attorney to send a letter to Mr. Arnold indicating the Board's position on this matter and compliance with the law. Mr. Pilcher seconded. Motion carried with Mr. Jones abstaining.
- (C) Board Regulation of Firms undergoing Peer review: The Board discussed firms that receive adverse or modified Peer Reviews and the Board's ability to regulate them. Currently the Board cannot require firms to comply with educational and remedial stipulations set forth by Administering Organizations. The Board concluded that its regulatory authority should be studied, focusing on ways to enforce compliance. Legal counsel will be needed to analyze any necessary changes to the Accountancy Act and Rules. ISCPA would like an opportunity to discuss the issue with their members, and consider any legislative changes for the 2004 Legislative Session. Mr. Jones will discuss the issue with the ISCPA Peer Review Committee at their October 2002 meeting.
- (D) Appointment to Replace Out-going Peer Review Oversight Committee Member: The Board is seeking one or two names for appointment to the Oversight Committee. Appointments will be made at the December 2002 Board meeting.

4. PROPOSED LEGISLATION

(A) HB 485 Technical Corrections: Ms. Porter presented for the Board's consideration, draft legislation to address issues arising from last year's changes to the Accountancy Act. Melissa Nelson with ISCPA and Linda Trent with IAPA have read and support the changes. Mr. Rasmussen moved to accept the proposed changes to the Accountancy Act for submission to the Governor's office for the 2003 Legislative Session. Mr. Bird seconded. Motion carried.

(B) Non-Renewal - Lapsed Status vs. Suspension: Ms. Porter explained that the legislative proposal would allow Board staff to automatically place a non-renewed license into lapsed status thirty days after the renewal deadline, thus avoiding the hearing process and suspension of a license. The holder of a lapsed license must go through the reinstatement process to return the license to active status.

5. HEARING

The CPE Committee denied hours and ordered Mr. Clive Cushing to do replacement and penalty hours in order to renew his CPA license. Mr. Cushing did not complete the ordered CPE. He asked the Board to review his CPE credits. Ms. Pumphrey chaired the hearing and Mr. Hunter presented the Board's case. After hearing both sides, Mr. Bird moved to grant nine of the twenty CPE hours denied for Mr. Cushing in 2001 for a total of thirty-nine CPE hours accepted. Mr. Rasmussen seconded. Motion carried.

6. EXAMINATION

(A) Approve November 2002 applicants: Mr. Bird moved to approve the following list of applicants for the November 2002 CPA Exam, including the special consideration applicants, provided there was no criminal history disclosed by the Department of Law Enforcement on AP-001595. Mr. Rasmussen seconded. Motion carried.

8. DISCUSSION OF TOPICS OF INTEREST

- (A) Sarbanes-Oxley Bill: Mr. Bird summarized the implications of federal legislation that directs the SEC to name a Public Company Accountability Oversight Board. The federal law sets out restrictions and requirements for firms that audit publicly traded companies. The Board discussed the possibility of future regulatory changes that could expand these requirements to auditing procedures regardless of whether or not the company is publicly traded. NASBA and AICPA are examining the issues, and may set a national precedence. Some individual states, such as California and New York, have begun to make state specific adaptations.
- (B) NASBA Bylaws Changes: The Board voiced support for changes proposed by NASBA and directed Ms. Pumphrey to so vote at the NASBA Annual Meeting.

9. DIRECTORS REPORT

Ms. Porter presented a list of activities for July through September 2002 for the Board's information. Mr. Rasmussen moved to approve the granting of one day of leave to each of the classified staff for use at the holidays provided that full office coverage is maintained. Mr. Etter seconded. Motion carried.

10. TREASURERS REPORT

Ms. Porter and Mr. Rasmussen presented the Treasurers Report for Fiscal Year 2002 ending June 30, 2002, and also for Fiscal Year 2003 year-to-date through September. Ms. Porter reported on the current financial situation of state government and the Governor's directives to state agencies.

11. APPOINTMENTS AND SCHEDULE DECEMBER BOARD MEETING

- (A) Ms. Pumphrey announced Governor Kempthorne's reappointment of Donald C. Etter to another five-year term as the Board's public member. Ms. Pumphrey made the following committee appointments: Samuel K. Cotterell, Chair of the Investigative Committee; J. Thomas Jones, Board liaison to the Peer Review Oversight Committee; and R. Craig Rasmussen, Board liaison to the Continuing Professional Education Committee.
